RESPONSIBLE SERVICE OF ALCOHOL POLICY

THE STADIUM IS COMMITED TO THE RESPONSIBLE SERVICE OF ALCOHOL

RESPONSIBLE SERVICE PRACTICES

- All staff involved with the sale and supply of alcohol will be RSA trained and accredited.
- An incident log will be maintained for all licensing matters.
- When alcohol is available for consumption, substantial food will be available.
- Free drinking water will be available for patrons on request.
- Non-alcoholic beverages and low and mid-strength alcohol beverages are included in our product range.
- In selected public areas, standard spirit measures (only) will be served, accompanied by a non-alcoholic mixer.
- A maximum of four (4) alcoholic beverages per person, per transaction will be sold / served.

However, cup limits may vary from event to event.

- The Stadium will not conduct promotions that encourage excessive or rapid drinking.
- Alcoholic beverages cannot be brought on-site by patrons. Fines may apply.
- Alcoholic beverages cannot be removed from the Stadium by patrons.

UNDERAGE PATRONS (Under 18 Years of Age)

- Patrons believed to look under 25 years of age, may be requested to provide valid identification.
- Underage persons purchasing a consuming alcohol, or persons supplying alcohol to underage patrons will be reported to the NSW Police. Fines may apply.

SUPPLYING ALCOHOL TO INTOXICATED PATRONS

•Persons supplying alcohol to persons deemed to be intoxicated, or on the verge of intoxication, will be reported to the NSW Police. Fines may apply.

MANAGEMENT OF INTOXICATED PERSONS / ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR

- Persons deemed to be intoxicated, or on the verge of intoxication will be refused entry to the Stadium.
- Persons deemed to be intoxicated, or on the verge of intoxication will be refused service.
- Intoxicated persons will be refused service and will be removed from the Stadium.
- •Persons who cause a disturbance or refuse to comply with requests from Stadium staff or NSW Police, will be removed from the Stadium. Fines may apply.
